Preparation & Directions

- 1. Prep the Surface
 - Ensure the surface is sanded, clean of debris, dry, and free from any holes, cracks, and/or surface scratches.
 - Use primer on raw/unfinished wood.
- 2. Spray outdoors or in well ventilated area when temperatures is between 68° and 78°F and humidity is below 60% to ensure proper drying.
 - Mask surrounding area where over spraying might settle.
- 3. Take Protective Measures
 - Use goggles, wear a mask, cover your head with a shower cap (or similar), utilize gloves, etc.
- 4. Shake can for at least 1-minute, listening for rattle of mixing ball prior to initial use.
 - Shake for 10-seconds at 1-2 minute intervals during application.
- 5. Hold can 6 to 10 inches from surface to prevent overspraying.
 - Press spray button firmly during use.
 - Do not cover with continuous spray. Move back and forth releasing the spray head after each stroke. Overlap each stroke.
- 6. Provide Enough Time for Drying In-Between Multiple Coats (Approx. 25-30 minutes)
 - For best results, apply two thin coats, rather than one heavy coat.
